Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Soft Skills was conducted by IQAC of St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology Patna in collaboration with Joseph's Academy for Soft Skills (JASS) of St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli.

It was a six-day online FDP organized on a National level through Google Meet. Fr Dr Martin Poras, SJ was the organizer, whereas Sr Dr Grace SCSC was the Convener and Dr Ashok Kumar was the Co-convener of the FDP. It was held from 30th January 2023 to 4th February 2023 from 05:00 PM to 07:00 PM. The registration fee for the same was Rs 500/-. The FDP was compulsory for in-house faculty members. The eighty-four participants were form across the India. (Bihar, Assam, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal).

30th January 2023, Day 1:

Resource Person: Dr A. John Balaiah, Coordinator, JASS (Joseph's Academy of Soft Skills), Asst. Professor of Counselling Psychology, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli

On the first day Dr A. John Balaiah discussed the "Dimensions of Soft Skills". He discussed on the importance of soft skills and how it helps to succeed in life. Education basically provides the hard skills which improves our intelligence but soft skills set us apart to make a good impression and succeed in life. Soft skills gives one, the ability for adaptive and positive behavior that enable individuals to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life. He also discussed about the core set of soft skills and informed how students with no soft skills suffer in life.

31st January 2023, Day 2:

Resource Person- Dr K. Alex, Soft Skillls Trainer & Associate Professor of Commerce, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli

On the second day Dr K Alex discussed about "Integrating Professionalism into Teaching". He explained, what the role of a teacher in someone's life. How they can transform their lives for the good. They must bear the qualities to touch the hearts of the students. He urged the teachers not to settle for less and keep aspiring, keep inspiring and keep transforming.

1st February 2023, Day 3:

Resource Person- Dr J John Love Joy, Asst. Professor of English, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli

On the third day Dr J John Love Joy discussed about "Effective Communication". He discussed how effective communication helps in communicating what we actually want to convey to other. He also discussed how one word can be used differently in different situation, the use of voice modulation and tone of voice, how stressing on a word in sentence can change the meaning of the sentence and the effect of body language while communicating.

2nd February 2023, Day 4:

Resource Person- Dr K Alex, Soft Skillls Trainer & Associate Professor of Commerce, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli

On the fourth day Dr K Alex discussed on "Decide Your Tomorrow Today".

He discussed on how planning in advance helps. He said that the Professors should have a giraffe's vision and heart. As giraffe is so tall, it can look up to a long distance and it also has the biggest heart. So, should have a Professor. He also said that we must be mindful of what we intake emotionally, spiritually and physically. We must deserve first, then desire. For this we need to believe in ourselves, our potential and our mission.




