- iii. To have a detailed discussion on the emerging trends in the teaching pedagogy of higher education and latest trends in the field of research

3. A brief summary with Geo-tagged photos:

DAY 1

The five days Faculty Development Program on "Innovations in Teaching Pedagogy and Research Trends" is jointly organized by IQAC, Patna Women's College and St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology. The faculty members were intimated about the FDP on 21 June 2023 through WhatsApp. The detailed schedule of the FDP was shared on the same date.

The first day started with a soulful prayer led by Sr. Celine Cresta AC, the HOD of the department of History, Patna Women's College. The moderator for the day Dr Amrita Chowdhury, Co-ordinator, IQAC, PWC then requested the dignitaries to commence the event by lighting the holy lamp. After the lamp lighting, Dr Sr. M Rashmi AC (Principal, PWC), Dr Fr. L. Joji Reddy SJ (Chairman, Xavier Board of Higher Education in India), Dr Fr. Martin Poras SJ (Principal, SXCMT), Dr Sr. Teresa CSST (Secretary General, XBHEI) and Dr Fr. Gilbert Mascarenhas SAC (Vice-Chairman, XBHEI) were requested to be seated on the dice where they were felicitated.

Dr Sr. M. Rashmi AC, Principal, PWC initiated the session with her address. She applauded the role and contribution of Xavier Board of Higher Education in India in Indian education system. She emphasized the role of Patna Women's College in the

higher education for women in Bihar. Dr Rashmi highlighted the need and importance of such Faculty Development Programs.

Dr Fr. L. Joji Reddy SJ, Chairman, Xavier Board of Higher Education in India started his keynote address by thanking the management for the warm welcome. He then discussed the human tendency of making promises but failing to deliver. In his words, "We make so many promises to others but how many times we keep the promise?" Fr. Reddy expressed the institutional responsibility of chiselling out the very best out of the students and the educator's role in it.

Fr. Reddy described the three pillars of education, i.e. academic excellence, social commitment and empowerment. He also shed light on the balance of responsibility and accountability. He went on talking about optimism and its relationship with perception. He said and I quote "The more you are optimistic, the better you'll have the perception". Fr. Reddy the pointed out the difference between a teacher (one who teaches a subject), an Aachaarya (one who inculcates the skills) and a Guru (one who can dispel the darkness from the mind of students).

Then he discussed different levels of learning (based on Bloom's taxonomy) and various teaching practices such as teaching clarity, classroom discussion, feedback, assessment, meta-cognitive strategies etc. He elaborated the changing technological sphere and its impact on education system. Fr. Reddy then highlighted the need of keeping us updated technologically as the AI, AR, VR and other means of ICT devices getting common among students.

Other highlights of his address were discussions on gamification, personalized learning, blended learning, inquiry based learning, experiential and collaborative learning competency based learning, multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary and trans disciplinary research and start-up ecosystem.

The second session resumed after a short break. Dr Fr. Martin Poras SJ, Principal, SXCMT addressed the house and shared his insights about the need of such FDP. In his words, "The FDP holds great significance as it aims to empower ourselves to empower students".

The plenary session was focused on the topic "Empowering Minds, Enriching Futures: Embracing NEP 2020 in the Higher Education Ecosystem". Dr Sr. Teresa CSST, Secretary General, XBHEI highlighted the need, significance and challenges of New Education Policy 2020. Sr. Teresa started her address with the evolution of the educational policies and then discussed their need and significance. She went on discussing the objective, challenges and consequences of the NEP 2020. Other highlights of her address were discussions on Operationalization of Multidisciplinary Universities and HEI Clusters, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), Curriculum and Credit Framework, Setting-up and operation of campuses of foreign higher educational institutions in India, Institutional Development Plan (IDP), UTSAH Portal, Professor of Practice (PoP) Scheme, Mulya Pravah 2.0, Higher Education Regulatory System and many other topics mentioned the NEP 2020. She suggested that the collaboration of various bodies and systems are the only way forward in order to successfully implement the NEP 2020.

The vote of thanks was proposed by Mr Alok John, Dean, National, International Collaborations & Consultancy Services, PWC.

DAY 2

Key highlights of the report- There were two sessions held on the second day of the FDP. The resource person of the first session was Fr. Ignatius Toppo, Principal, St. Xavier's College, (Autonomous) Patna. The topic of this session was 'Enhancing Effective Classroom Management'. In his address, Fr. Ignatius touched upon various facets of effective classroom management which are mentioned hereunder;

To be the best teacher, one should take care of various factors such as maintaining discipline in the class, being prepared for the class, ensuring that students are motivated to attend the class, providing a safe, comfortable and learning environment, builing self-esteem of the students and being creative in the class.

Teaching style is different for everyone and it depends on various variables like teaching style, personality of the teacher, student population, to name a few. It's important to understand that not all management strategies are effective for every teacher.

The teacher should always be willing to learn. Students are morality police as they can spot inconsistencies in our teaching and conduct quite easily. Knowing students by their names goes a long way in building professional rapport with them.

Teachers should plan their lessons efficiently to minimize the down time (a span of time without a planned activity).

Teachers should be on time for their classes and should be prepared to accommodate last-minute changes in the plan.

As teachers, we should anticipate possible hiccups in our lessons and activities.

Reflective Planning-Focus attention on the entire class so that everyone feels involved. At times, silence is the best tool to deal with any undesirable behavior. We should allow room for proximity control.

With-it-ness- It refers to a teacher's awareness of what is going on in the class. When handling misbehavior, we should ensure that students learn what is unacceptable about that behavior. The underlying objective is to bring positive change in the student.

We must deal with misbehavior without disrupting the academic activity. The primary reasons for misconduct are power, revenge, to seek attention, and the desire to be left alone.

Session-2 Resource Person- Fr. (Dr.) Martin Poras SJ, Principal, SXCMT Patna

The topic of this session was 'Role of Teachers in the Formation of Students'. The resource person began his address with an analogy where he compared the mind of a student with Tabla Rasa which basically means an empty slate. What is written on that slate is largely shaped by the teacher. He said that unlike other institutions, PWC and SXCMT are part of a social project where the goal of imparting education is not limited to merely awarding of degrees. We consider students as the spirit of God and hence, teaching is a sacrosanct duty for us. Other important points discussed were;

Every student has immense potential and it's our duty to help him realize it.

The concept of self-actualization popularized by American psychologist Abraham Maslow. The concept talks about how self-actualization can emerge as a motivator and help one realize one's greatest potential.

A good teacher doesn't tell his students to study. Instead, he makes them fall in love with learning.

The resource person further elaborated this point by narrating a story of two boys who were trying in vain to drag a calf back to its shelter. Seeing this, the girl who owned the calf just patted its head and surprisingly, the calf followed her to the barn. The takeaway from this story is that at times, we as teachers try to force our ideas on the students which kills their ability of independent thinking and encourages rote learning.

Eight stages of human development propounded by psychologist Erik Erikson. The eight stages are Infancy, Toddler, Pre-school, Early school, Adolescence, Young Adulthood, Middle Age, Older Adulthood.

Discipline problem in colleges- While dealing with indiscipline, we should understand that students are not finished products, Rather, they are work in progress. Hence, we can't expect them to be perfect. We as teachers should be role models for our students. In this light, we should bear in mind the 80:20 Rule i.e. the Pareto Principle which asserts that 80% of the output comes from 20% of causes.

R+R-R = R+R - It implies that rules and regulation - relationship lead to resentment + rebellion

Try to influence and motivate rather than manage. Teachers should have a positive influence on the students through their words and deeds.

The resource person concluded the session with a short story which highlighted the message that if one is willing to do something, one will always find the ways and means of doing it. On the contrary, if one is not enthusiastic to do something, there is no dearth of excuses. The moral of the story was nothing is impossible to a willing mind!

DAY 3

The five days Faculty Development Program on "Innovations in Teaching Pedagogy and Research Trends" is jointly organized by IQAC, Patna Women's College and St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology. The faculty members were intimated about the FDP on 21 June 2023 through WhatsApp. The detailed schedule of the FDP was shared on the same date. The FDP started on 3 July 2023.

The Third day started with a soulful prayer led by Sr. Celine Cresta AC, the HOD of the department of History, Patna Women's College. The moderator for the day Ms. Puia,

Mr.Alok John, Dean, National, International Collaborations & Consultancy services, Patna Women's College, Autonomous started the session on "Strategies for Enterprising Teaching".

The session included very detailed sharing on the topic followed by a practical session wherein the resource person shared with every participant a worksheet on GETT. Further he elaborated the outcomes for each individual based on criteria wise scores and helped the participants evaluate their individual appetite for enterprise in teaching. The vote of thanks was proposed by Ms Puja.

DAY 4

The first session was conducted by Dr. Sumanta Datta, Assistant Professor, PG & Research Department of Commerce, St. Xavier College (Autonomous), Kolkata. This session was conducted online.

The thrust of the 1st session of Dr, Sumanta Datta was "Research Ethics". Dr. Datta enunciated why is research necessary for teachers engaged in higher education. He said that teachers are important stakeholders and they should not only engaged in research themselves to continuously upgrade their knowledge to be better able to help their students but they should also be aware of what is ethical and what is not ethical in research practices.

He mentioned that there has been a rise in unethical research practices in the past. The reasons cited by Dr. Datta were – i) constant pressure to publish in academics; ii) difficulty of publication and iii) publications are a requirement by different accrediting agencies like NAAC/DO/SCS-SSI

Dr. Datta explained what is construed as Research Ethics. It is a codification of scientific morality in practice, referring to doing what is morally and legally right in research. He said that under pressure to publish many of us pay to get our papers published in scopus journals which is unethical.

There are many types of Research Fraud. Dr. Datta talked about Falsification, Fabrication and Plagiarism (FFP).

Data fabrication is when the researcher did not actually do the study but faked the data. Falsification is when the researcher did the experiment but changed some of the data. He went on to mention the penalties for such acts. He said that if the publication finds out about data fabrication and/or falsification then the publication will retract the research paper which means that the author/authors will be blacklisted from that

publication. The heads of HEI are also informed about such cases and they also take action against the errant author/authors.

Dr. Datta talked about Creative Common Licenses that give everyone from individuals to large institutions a standardized way to grant the public permission to use their creative work under copyright law. He introduced the concept of CC while talking about plagiarism.

Plagiariam is described as an act of academic dishonesty and a breach of ethics. (UGC, 2018). It is "the appropriation of another person's ideas, processes, results, or words without giving appropriate credit". Dr. Datta went on to elaborate on different types of plagiarism. There is patchwork plagiarism, self-palgiarism, direct plagiarism, and idea plagiarism. He discussed in detail about all these types of plagiarism and why they were harmful to the research culture. He also enlightened us about UGC's policy on plagiarism. There are no penalties for minor similarities. For students, in similarities below 40%, the concerned student will have to re submit the paper in the next 6 months. In similarities between 40%-60%, the student will be debarred from submitting a revised paper for the next one year and in similarities above 60% the registration of the student will be cancelled.

Penalty for plagiarism at the level of teachers are as follows:- similarities between 10%-40% the researcher will be asked to withdraw the manuscript. In similarities between 40%-60% the researcher will shall be asked to withdraw the manuscript, the researcher will be denied the right to one annual increment and shall not be allowed to be a supervisor to any Master's, M.Phil or PhD students for a period of two years. In case of above 60% similarities the researcher will be asked to withdraw the manuscript, shall be denied the right to two successive increments, and shall not be allowed to be a supervisor to any Master's, M.Phil or PhD students for a period of three years.

Dr. Datta went on to tell us how to avoid plagiarism. To avoid plagiarism he said, "don't copy, write your own ideas, don't recycle images, texts and tables that you have used earlier in previously published papers. Ask for permission if we have to use a figure, table, or any other data that has not been published before.

He informed us about COPE (Committee on Publishing Ethics) DAIP (Departmental Academic Integrity Panel) and IAIP (Institutional Academic Integrity Panel). He spoke about different types of authorship and how Ghost authorship, Guest authorship and Gift authorships were unethical. He explained in detail what kind of authorships were acceptable and considered ethical and legal.

He encouraged us to create an ORCID id which would help us submit our papers to authentic journals. He cautioned us against fake journals and publications. He said that the ORCID id will permanently link an author with their research outputs.

Winding up his discourse he cautioned us against fake journals and publications which are on the rise because of the "Publish or Perish" pressures created for academics as a condition for employment, promotion, and even maintaining one's job. According to him the POP culture has led to a relentless quest for publication – the sole objective being CV building rather than the advancement of human knowledge. He said that often the universities require their faculty members and students to publish regularly and this "pressure to publish" may lead to a variety of unethical practices. Dr. Datta gave an overview of the types of predatory journals that fall into four broad categories, namely – i) Shoddy/Sham Journals, ii) Cloned Journals, iii) Hijacked journals, iv) Crony publishing. Dr. Datta gave us guiedlines to check whether a journal was legitimate or

The second session was led by Dr. Amrita Chowdhury, IQAC, Patna Women's College (Autonomous), Patna. The thrust of Dr. Chowdhury's presentation was "Tapping the Opportunities for Research Projects/Fellowships".

She said that research is not optional but mandatory for teachers in Higher Education Institution. Working on Research Projects and/or Fellowships are very important for an academic in HEI.

She mentioned that although there are many opportunities for research and fellowships, competition is also increasing. Research is important not just as a criterion demanded by the university but is also important for growth as an educator/explorer. It is important for institutional growth, societal growth and also helps in NAAC/NIRF/ and other rankings.

She gave us information about research projects for faculty members. She said that various central/state government/ corporate/ non-government bodies/ commissions/organisations provide funds for undertaking research projects. These research projects are generally categorised as Major or Minor Research Projects.

She answered some Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) about the research projects like Eligibility Criteria, Funding and supporting agencie – when/where.how to apply? Selection of topic, preparing the proposal, budgeting and post approval formalities.

She explained about Research Fellowships – which are a merit based doctoral/post - doctoral research or for advanced studies in National/ Inter-National Universities or research Institutes. Fellowships are also given by National/International Organizations, Departments, Private Organizations, Trusts, Foundations, Commissions, etc.

She explained about Fullbright Fellowships and the eligibility criteria for the three different levels of Fullbright Fellowships.

She also informed us about ICSSR Fellowship which again has three different levels of fellowships for different categories of researchers and scholars. She mentioned many other options besides these two options of fellowships.

She went on to give us tips to remember before applying. She explained to us in detail on how to draft our research proposal. She also mentioned the importance of Principal Investigator/Research Director. She encouraged us to be open to collaboration.

Dr. Chowdhury explained in great detail the application procedure for gaining a research project or a fellowship. She also gave valuable tips in how to select a topic for research, quoting from Einstein, "Imagination is the highest form of Research".

She encouraged us to dive into research even if we were not to well versed in that topic because that is the ultimate purpose of research. To enhance our knowledge.

She gave us inputs on the Components of the Research Proposal in detail. She helped us understand Budgeting and said that we need to keep to the budget as well as the timelines mentioned by us in the research proposal. Failure to maintain the budgetary limits and timelines can lead to researchers losing their reputation.

She emphasised the importance of documentation once the research proposal has been approved and funds released. She said to strictly follow the guidelines.

She gave us detailed instructions on how to plan, manage, monitor, complete and submit the report. Winding up her discourse she said, "Don't worry about Research, Just Search".

DAY 5

The fifth day of five day Faculty Development Program on "Innovations in Teaching Pedagogy and Research Trends" jointly organized by IQAC, Patna Women's College and St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology, started with a soulful prayer led by Sr. Celine Cresta AC, the HOD of the department of History, Patna Women's College. The moderator for the day was Dr Pallavi.

Resource person for session 1- Dr Prabhat Kumar, Professor, Department of Computer Science & Engineering, NIT, Patna started the session on "ICT Enabled Pedagogical Practise". He discussed various types of human memory- Very Short Term Memory

(Ultra Short Term), Short Term Memory (Working Memory), Long Term Memory, Episodic memory, Semantic memory, Implicit Memory and procedural Memory.


Emphasising on human memory and its types Dr Prabhat Kumar explained of five different pedagogical approaches of teaching-Constructive Approach, Collaborative Approach, Inquiry Based Approach, Integrative Approach and Reflective Approach. 



During the session Dr Sinha shared uses of a list of platforms and applications- Menti.com, Chat GPT, Google doc, Google Form, edpuzzle.com, Gamma.app, Tome.app, cleanup.pictures, educationcopilot.ai and many other.


