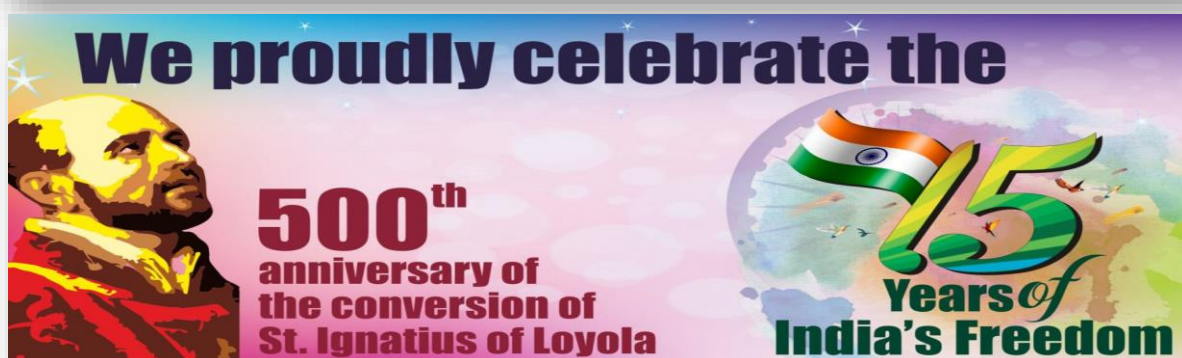
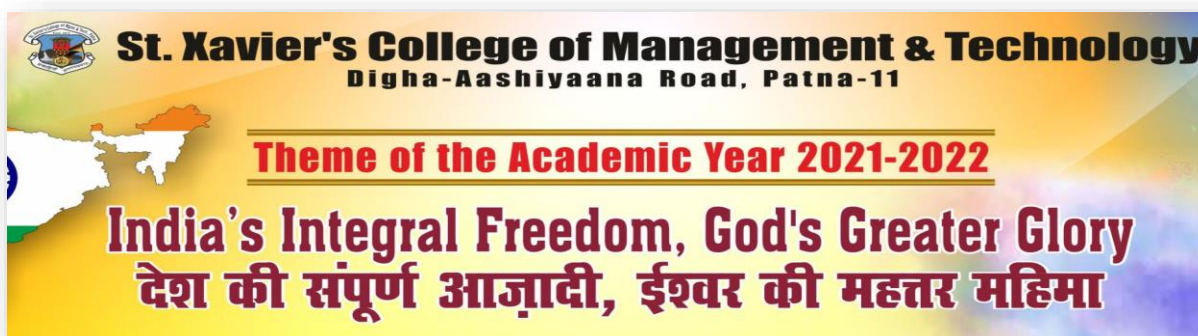
Introduction
