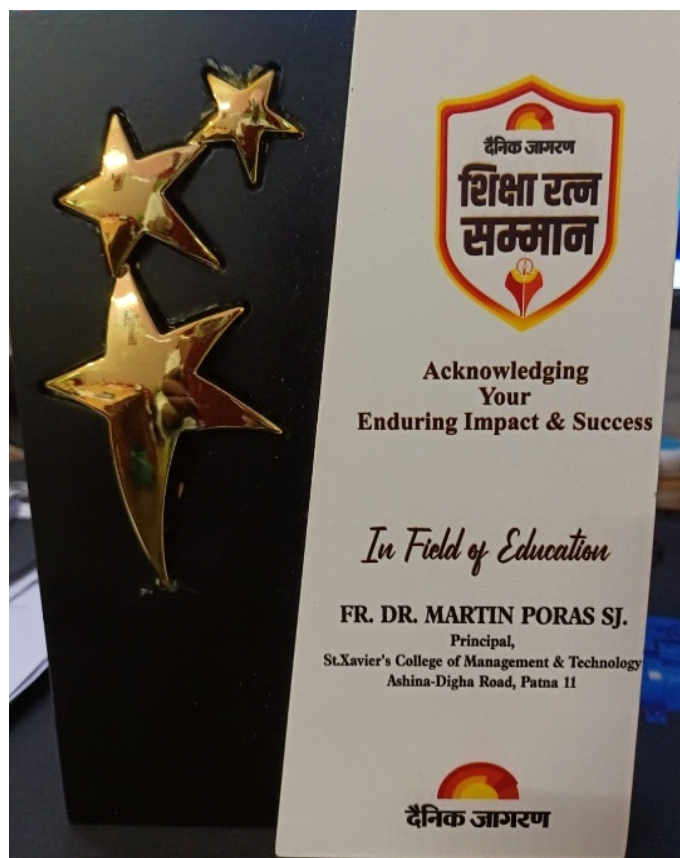

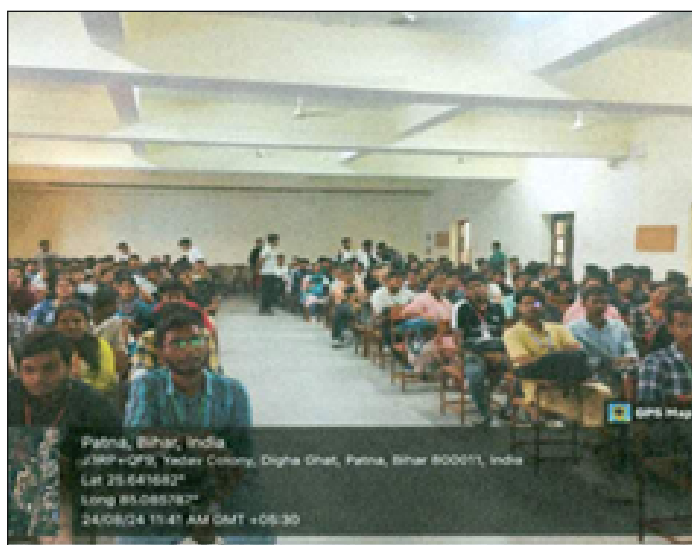
Session on “Developing IoT and Robotics” (Date- 27-07-2024)

The Second International Conference on Advancements in Science, Technology and Management (ICASTM-II) 2025 (Date- 11 – 12 April 2025)

The Second International Conference on Advancements in Science, Technology and Management (ICASTM-II) 2025, organized by the Department of Computer Science, St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology, Patna, was held on April 11–12, 2025. The conference brought together researchers, academicians, and industry experts from 10 countries and 76 institutions, with 162 papers accepted out of 304 submissions. Ghofur (Indonesia) and Mr. Venkateshparan Parthasarathy (USA) on bridging the digital divide and AI in supply chain management. Across two days, 11 parallel technical sessions were conducted, covering diverse themes such as Artificial Intelligence, IoT, Cybersecurity, Healthcare Technology, Environmental Sustainability, and Business Management. Notable faculty presentations included topics on food security and IoT-based health monitoring. The conference concluded with a valedictory session, award announcements, and participant feedback. ICASTM-II 2025 successfully promoted academic excellence, interdisciplinary research, and global collaboration in emerging areas of science and technology.



Seminar on Internship and Project Work for BCA (Date 30-04-2025)

On 30th April 2025, the Department of Computer Science at St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology, Patna, in collaboration with the Placement Cell, organized a seminar on Internship and Project Work for BCA 2nd year students. 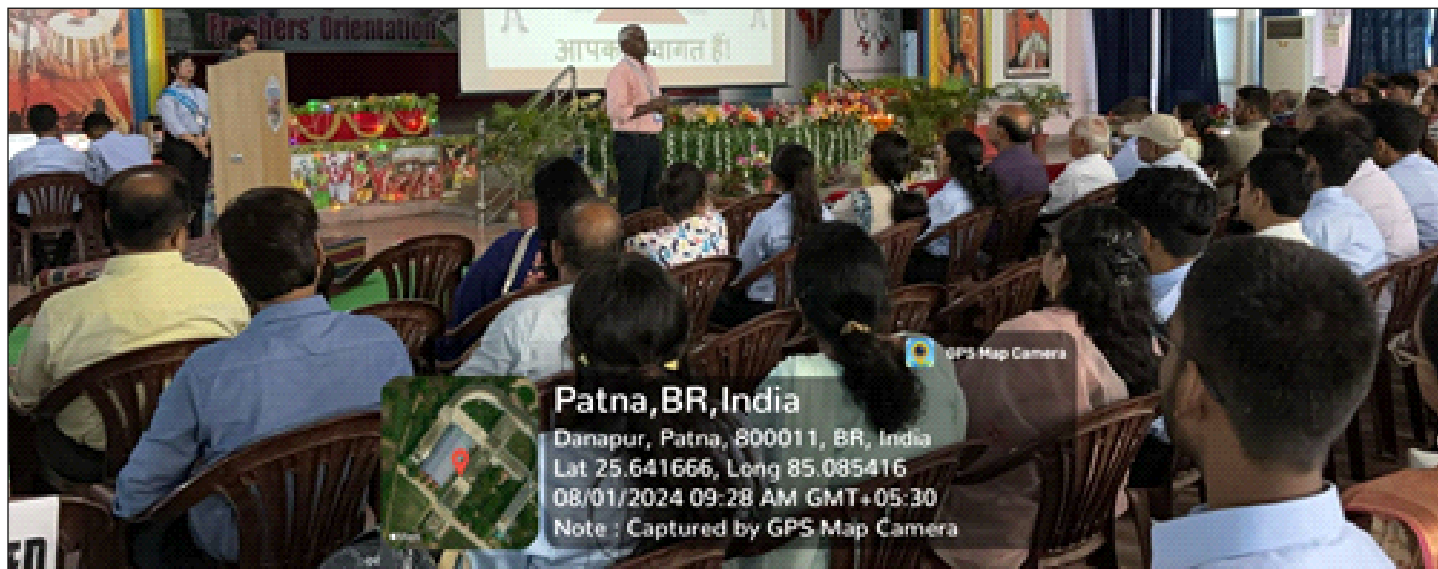

Academic Activity Committee

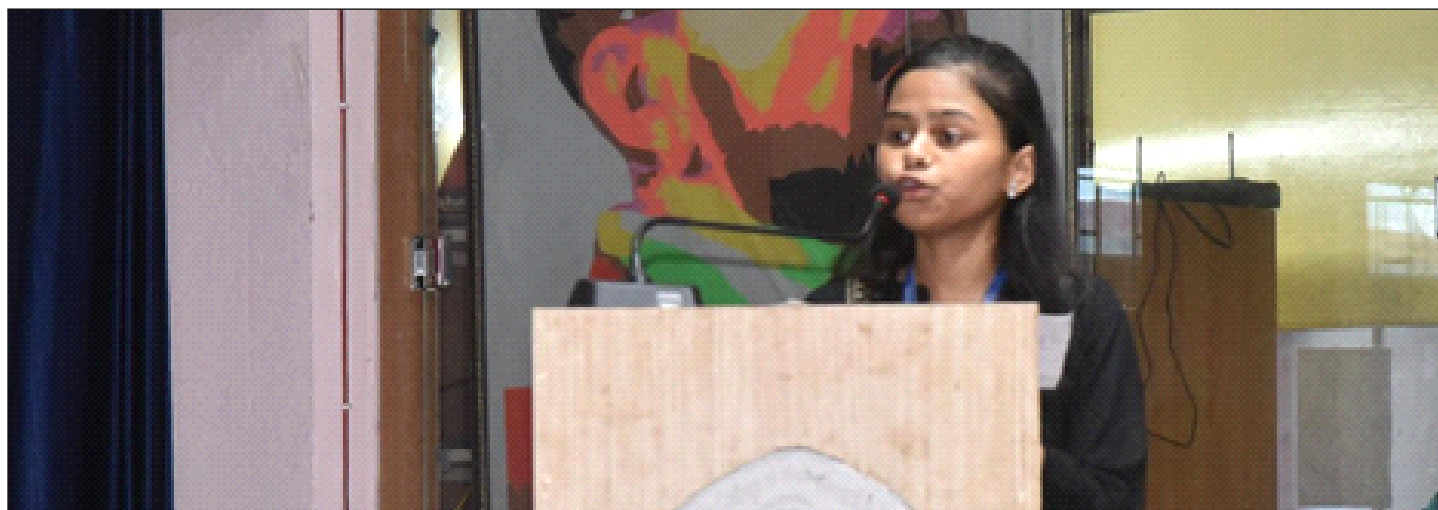
Orientation Programme

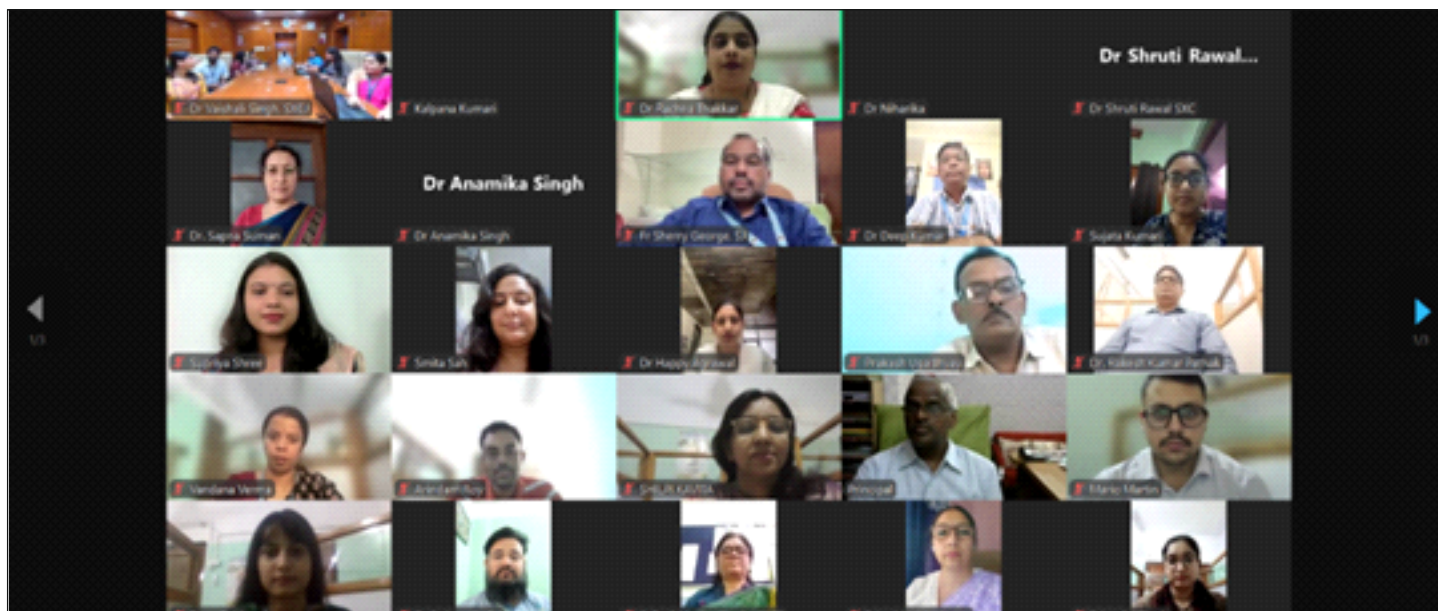
Parents-Professor Meet
